### Mt. Halla

#### Presenting Nature's Mysteries by Season!

Mt. Halla, standing at the center of Jeju Island, is the highest in South Korea, 1950 meters above sea level. On its top lies a 1.6ha crater of a 550m circumference and 108m deep size. Despite its high altitude, Mt. Halla has four distinctive seasons, presenting seasonal beauties of its own. Among other things, unusual rock formations called 500 Nahan produce magnificent scenic views.

Mt. Halla, created by volcanic activities, has approximately 368 peaks called oreum, which provide panoramic views. Small and big oreums are scattered around the whole island, which have been regarded as unique natural heritages along with lava tubes.

### Seongsan Ilchulbong

#### Magnificent Sunrise, Palace on the Ocean

Seongsan Ilchulbong, located at the east of Jeju Island, is a tourist destination. Many people visit on the new year's day to pray for their wishes toward the rising sun. It has been regarded as one of the top ten beautiful sights in Jeju. It is highly praised for its beautiful scenic view as well as for the value of scientific investigation by the world.

Seongsan Ilchulbong was formed by the volcanic eruption under the shallow water at the mid Pleistocene Epoch. The original shape of the crater is well preserved. The various formations created at the time of the eruption along the coastal cliffs provide valuable scientific materials for volcanology.

### Geomun Oreum Lava Tube System


#### The mystery of ancient times remains in Jeju.

Jeju Island is called a mysterious treasury of more than 120 lava tubes. Among other things, the lava tube system of Geomun Oreum, located at the east of Jeju Island, is the most valued one. Numerous lava tubes were created by the volcanic eruption from Geomun Oreum. Manjang Cave, Bengdi Cave, Gimnyeong Cave, Yongcheon Cave and Dangcheomul Cave are the highest valued among the lava tubes.

In terms of form, size and structure, each lava tube has its own unique characteristics, which have a highly regarded reputation from all over the world. Above all, the magnificent limestone caves of Yongcheon Cave and Dangcheomul Cave are considered the most valuable caves in the world. In addition, the lava pillars in Manjang Cave are regarded as the biggest in the world.



# Island of Culture



## Choga (Straw Thatched House)

Jeju's thatched house called "Choga" shows the wisdom of our ancestors, who made great efforts to survive in a harsh windy area. The roof was covered with grass called 'Sae' instead of rice straw, weaved into a checked shape by using well-twisted straw ropes. The thatched house was built low to escape from strong wind. Compared to the mainland, Jeju has strong wind and heavy rain. So the outer walls of a thatched house were made from mud and stone.

## Mulheobeok

Jeju suffered from water shortages, so women had to walk a long distance with a water pot called "Mulheobeok" on their backs to carry water home. So, their water pots had narrow mouths and flat bottoms. Mulheobeok was put in a bamboo basket called "Gudeok" when carried on one's back. The water in Mulheobeok was poured in the water pot at the corner of the kitchen. When pouring water into the pot, women had to bend themselves with Mulheobeok on their backs.



## Jeongnang

Jeju people used three long logs called "Jeongnang" at the gates of their houses during their absence. The logs were hanged onto the holes of the stone pillars at both sides of the gate. One log meant "returning shortly", two meant "returning later" and three meant "out-all-day".



## Jeju's Stone

Jeju people used to live in houses made of stone. It is no exaggeration to say that they lived along with stone from birth. Their houses were made of stone and so were the fences and the passages called "Olrae." Even the roads were covered with stone. So they used to wear shoes made of tough a row of vines for comfortable passage on stone. It's impossible to consider Jeju people's life without mentioning stone. It was often said that Jeju people were born on stone and ended their lives with stone.


## Dolharubang

Stone Grandfather Statue called "Dolharubang" is one of the most distinguishing symbols of Jeju Island. He has prominent eyes, a blunt nose, a tightly closed mouth and a bulging belly. Each village has its own unique shape of Dolharubang.

Dolharubang, standing at the entrance of a village as a guardian, appears to symbolize the spirit of Jeju people who overcame difficulty and hardship.

## Woman Diver

You can easily see some woman divers working under water. You will notice the divers making whistling sounds as they come upper for gasping air. They can stay working under water 20 meters deep, holding their breath for more than 2 minutes. The sight of Jeju woman divers' catching marine products under water is picturesque and amazing.



# Hiking Trails in Mt. Halla



## Gwaneumsa Hiking Trail (one way: 8.7km)

It takes 8~9 hours to make around hiking trip to the top.

This trail used to be the main hiking trail to Baekrokdam before the 5.16 highway and the 1100 road were built. Although fewer hikers take this trail these days, many hiking maniacs still enjoy hiking along this trail because it presents panoramic views of Tamna Valley, Gaemimok and Samgakbong, etc.

## Eorimok Hiking Trail (one way: 4.7km)

It takes 4~5 hours to make around hiking trip to Witsae Oreum.

Eorimok hiking trail is favored because it is shorter than the others. Its final destination is Witsae Oreum via Sajaebi Hill and Mansae Hill. Seen from Mansae Hill, the scenery of the top of Mt. Halla is gorgeous.

## Yeongsil Hiking Trail (one way: 3.7km)


3~4 hours required for a round hiking trip to Witsae Oreum

Even a beginner can enjoy hiking along this trail because it is the shortest. In addition, this hiking trail presents unique and distinctive sceneries from season to season. Another attraction is a taste of fresh and clean water from "Norusaem."


## Seongpanak Hiking Trail (one way: 9.6km)

It takes 7~8 hours for a round hiking trip to the top.

This hiking trail is easier because it has a gradual slope. Especially in spring, the fields of azalea blossom attract many hikers because they present a magnificent view.

- Neither camping nor cooking is allowed. Preparing drinking water and snacks is advisable.
  - Hikers should take the regular trails for safety and nature conservation.
  - Before starting, please confirm the available hiking trails. To prevent excessive damage to hiking trails, some trails are alternatively prohibited.
  - The weather conditions on Mt. Halla are changeable according to altitude. Careful Preparation is advisable against unexpected weather conditions such as snow, rain, and wind, etc.
  - Hikers should get information in advance because time for ascending or descending may vary subject to season and trail.

It is the autonomous paradise which grants advanced autonomy to all fields, such as legislation except diplomacy and national defense, finances, an organization, and personnel affairs, and makes an autonomous model new for local autochthonous development.
